Huntington Arts Council is seeking an experienced Audio Engineer with a background in both analog and digital audio for live music concerts, dance and theatrical performances. The successful candidate will be hired as a seasonal employee by the Town of Huntington within the Dept. of Parks and Recreation.

On the days/nights the audio engineer is scheduled to work, they have the primary responsibility for setting up and operating the sound system at the Chapin Stage in Heckscher Park.

The Audio engineer will work in cooperation with the Performing Arts Director, Production Manager and chief Audio Engineer, Technical Staff and speak directly with the acts or their technical staff when necessary.

The ideal candidate will:

- Experience in the set up and operation of sound equipment and band gear
- Experience of maintenance and trouble-shooting of audio equipment
- Experience in working with stage crew and performers
- Have ability to lift 50 lbs.
